## **FROM THE PASTORS DESK**

### **Easter Octave**

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Anthony's,

Happy Easter!!!

As I said at all the Easter Masses on Easter Sunday, the Church prolongs the celebration for fifty days. The events of our Lord's resurrection so baffle the mind that it really is hard to comprehend. It is the miracle of miracles. How useless life would be if it were not for the Lord Jesus, through His resurrection to restore all humanity to its rightful place. We know that through the transgression of Adam, sin and death entered the world; so, through Jesus, life eternal would be bestowed upon all who believe.

Today is the second day of the Octave of Easter, and as I write I am reminded of the power of the Octave celebration. Easter is but a taste of what is to come. The word “taste” has an interesting connotation. We taste something as if to excite our desire for more of what we tasted; this is precisely what is going on in the Church's liturgy. We get an inkling of the Easter joy and it sustains us through life's ups and downs so that one day we will arrive at the full reality.

The sequence for Easter now follows. It is the early Churches song of victory:

“Christians, to the Paschal victim  
Offer your thankful praises!  
A Lamb the sheep redeems:  
Christ, who only is sinless,  
Reconciles sinners to the Father.  
Death and life have contended in that combat stupendous:  
The Prince of life, who died, reigns immortal.  
Speak, Mary, declaring what you saw, wayfaring:  
“The Tomb of Christ, who is living, The glory of Jesus’  
Resurrection; Bright angels attesting,  
The shroud and napkin resting.  
Yes, Christ my hope is arisen;  
To Galilee he will go before you.”  
Christ indeed from death is risen, our new life obtaining;  
Have mercy, victor King, ever reigning!  
Amen. Alleluia.

My favorite line is the one that says: “to Galilee He goes before you.” The Galilean ministry of Jesus was one filled with joy, love and excitement. In Galilee all things were good. Little wonder why Jesus wanted the first disciple to recapture the beauty of His Galilean ministry.

May the Lord bless you and your family during this Holy time.

## **THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER APRIL 15TH, 2018**

### **First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19**

Peter reminds the people that they allowed Jesus to be killed, and preferred to allow a murderer to be released. But God raised him from the dead as had been prophesied. Therefore, all people should believe and turn to God, that their sins might be forgiven.

### **Second Reading: 1 John 2:1-5a**

Jesus was offered up for the sins of the world. The only way to prove true faith in Him, is to honor his commandments. Anyone who claims to believe, yet does not keep his word, does not truly believe.

### **Gospel: Luke 24:35-48**

Jesus appeared to two disciples, though at first they feared he was a ghost. Jesus ate with them to prove he was not a ghost. He explained that he had fulfilled the prophets words about him. He also explained that in his name they must preach doing penance for the forgiveness of sins.
